Endangered Modernist Houses



Finally sold - but endangered? In 1980, after years of battling with the Modernist-hating Town of Southampton Architectural Review Board (ARB), **Orest Bliss** finally got to build his **Norman Jaffe**-designed house at 88 Meadow Lane. Fast forward 40+ years, including a non-Jaffe renovation, and Bliss wanted a demolition permit before putting the house on the market, as oceanfront properties

get a better price with pre-arranged permits. After lawsuits against the now-Modernist-loving ARB, Bliss got his permit and the house is sold at **\$22M**. The buyer, unknown at present, has the green light to tear it down if they wish.

Endangered alerts! Demolition is imminent for the **Frank Walser** House at 3350 Alamance Drive in Raleigh NC, a pristine **Milton Small** house in amazing condition. This will be the first loss in years of a significant Modernist house in Raleigh.

3401 Ocotea, Raleigh, is a gorgeous 1966 Modernist house, 2862 sf, on 3/4 of an acre. Clearly designed by an architect (though we don't know who), the **sales listing** had no interior photos, which is a surefire sign of intended teardown. \$795,000. Sold, but no word yet on the buyer or the house's fate.



Endangered: From a town known as Oyster Bay, Long Island, made famous in song by **Billy Joel**, there's a rare, long-neglected Burke House, 144 Center Island Road, **for sale on 17 acres** for \$6.75M. **Benjamin Thompson** of TAC was the project architect. TAC leader **Walter Gropius** was friends with the Burkes. No interior photos, being sold as land.

This one-of-a-kind, 1956 X-100 steel House of the Future that **A. Quincy Jones** and **Frederick Emmons** designed for developer **Joseph Eichler** in San Mateo CA is "poised" to be on the market for \$4.45M, according to multiple online news reports from **The Eichler Network**, MSN.com and *San Francisco Business Times*. As of last weekend, however, it did not appear on real estate websites. **Marty Arbunich**, founder of the Eichler Network, is the owner.



Martin Gelber designed the **1977 Gelber Residence in Los Angeles**, now for sale with a \$4.4M asking price.



Endangered: The 1953 Wade and Margaret Lewis Residence at 2700 Manning Place in Raleigh is one of the very few houses in North Carolina built over a stream. They don't let you do that anymore. Designed by **Milton Small**, the house was widely published when completed. This is the perfect project for someone who wants a classic midcentury modern to renovate. If that person doesn't materialize, the house will surely be destroyed. For sale **as-is for \$675,000**.



The 2011 House of Love that architect **Bob Hale** designed as his family home **is on the market with a \$5.3M price tag**. The upper part of the house in LA's Cheviot Hills neighborhood is wrapped in an aluminum screen perforated with Hebrew letters spelling the word "ahava" – "love."



Le Corbusier's 1930 Villa de Mandrot, a Riviera home designed for artist H el ene de Mandrot, **is on the market for about \$2.7M**.



A **1971 waterfront house** that architect **William Morris** designed in Pepper Pike, east of Cleveland OH, is on the market for a mittle over \$1.8M.

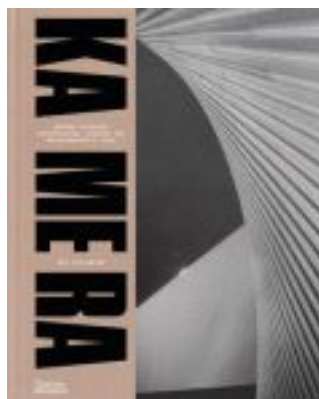

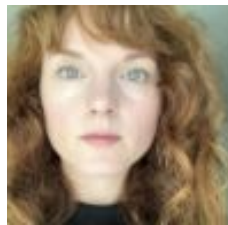
New Books

It's Matsumoto Prize time! In addition to new houses, NCModernist has added a new Renovations category for the 2026 Matsumoto Prize. This opens up the Prize for many creative solutions to expansion, restoration, and sustainability. The Matsumoto Prize is open to anyone with primary design responsibility for a Modernist house project located in North Carolina; the designer/architect can be from anywhere. There are now two Prize categories:

- Completely built, from-the-ground-up, single-family Modernist houses of at least 800 heated sf with a CO on or after January 1, 2021. No ADU's.
- Modernist renovations of single-family houses, at least 800 heated sf with a CO on or after January 1, 2021. No ADU's or separate additions. Attached additions only if the main house was also substantially renovated.

Submissions are open! **Deadline 5pm EST, April 29.** The 2026 George Matsumoto Prize Awards will be held at [Leland Little](#) in Hillsborough NC on July 22. [Details](#), or [skip right to the entry screen](#).



Vacancy, not development, is the enemy of mid-century Modernist houses. Preserve and protect the architecture you love by **notifying us** when North Carolina houses go vacant or on the market.

The **preservation easement** is one of the only legally enforceable ways to assure a Modernist house does not get destroyed by future owners. National Register status? Meaningless. Famous architect? Nope. Local historic designation? At best, a delay in demolition. And as history shows, there are plenty of smiling buyers who say, "I would never tear this down." Then after closing, it's gone. Think of the preservation easement as a homeowner's association for one house. The easement requires future owners to maintain the house in current structural condition and state of repair, or better, including necessary work to preserve its integrity. Here's a video featuring Preservation North Carolina and NCModernist, along with **Jane Levy**, who has an easement on her Greensboro Modernist home. Here's a sample **preservation easement document**.

There is another way, the deed restriction. Consider it "preservation easement lite." When a once-cherished residence falls into the hands of new owners, there is always the risk that it will be destroyed, despite promises to the contrary from those owners. One powerful legal tool families can use to guard against demolition is a **deed restriction**. Knowing that potential buyers can and do lie about destroying houses, a deed restriction is a legally enforceable binding promise attached to the property title. Unlike some historic designations, a deed restriction travels with the property through changes in ownership. Even if a buyer threatens to demolish or radically alter a house, they are limited by the deed. The restriction is usually ten years, and it becomes part of the chain of title. Implementing a deed restriction before a sale immediately scares off developers (or developers-in-hiding) in an owner-value-friendly way to protect a property.
